Field of the Invention This invention relates to a video signal processing apparatus for processing a video signal produced in a video tape recorder. 2. Description of the Prior Art Recently, video tape recorders of the D1 standard have been widely used. Since a color video signal of this standard is not as clear as a black-and-white video signal of the NTSC standard, a pre-emphasis or de-emphasis circuit is included in a video signal processing circuit to improve the quality of the color video signal. Generally, the waveform of a video signal is distorted when it is reproduced from a video tape recorder, particularly when the reproduction head moves across the record track. In the pre-emphasis circuit, a given pre-emphasis coefficient is used to amplify the amplified signal which has been distorted. The pre-emphasis coefficient is obtained based on the output of the post-erase amplifier when the system is in a normal state. Since the post-erase amplifier is used in the normal state, it is difficult to detect precisely the normal state. A: If you want to "pre-populate" one of your model's fields, you can use the Django pre_save signal, which will be triggered before saving the model. You'll get an instance of the model, and you can "set" the default in there.
